

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:

Westbound on Hwy #1

Take exit #160 that says "Laidlaw, Hunter Creek, Rest Area", go under the freeway to the second stop sign and turn right. You are now running parallel with the freeway heading towards Chilliwack. Go about 4 km, turn left at McKay Rd.

Eastbound on Hwy #1

Take exit #153 that says "Jones Lake, Laidlaw". The exit veers to the right. You are parallel with the freeway, still heading towards Hope. Go about 2 km, turn right on McKay Rd.

Using GPS:

Input address: 58428 McKay Road - tell your GPS to search all cities in BC - if it offers you Fraser Valley - choose that. The Garmin did not find it in Hope, or in Laidlaw - but it found it in Fraser Valley, British Columbia!

Co-ordinates: N49°19.351' W121°36.785' Elev: 16m

Motels & Camping Info:

Holiday Motel & RV Park

63950 Old Yale Road, Silver Creek, BC (604) 869-5352

Take the Silver Hope **Creek** exit #168. Veer off to the right and look for their sign on the right hand side just after you pass a Husky gas station on the right. The motel is only about 1km after the exit.

Camping may not be available on site this year due to pasture upgrading and maintenance. You may contact Downriver Farm in April to confirm this, or to see if we can make room for smaller rigs and tents. There are some nice campsites very close to the trial site, though.

The nicest campground that is not near train tracks or freeways, and is very pretty and private, is conveniently located right in downtown Hope. It fills up on long weekends so if you would like to get into this campsite we recommend that you reserve well in advance. It is called Coquihalla Campsite, 800 Kawkawa Lake Rd, phone (604) 869-7119. The campsite is dog friendly and is located along the Coquihalla River. Let them know you are coming for the trials at Jim & Lynn's place.

Whistlestop Campground is located at 59440 St. Elmo Rd., Laidlaw, phone (604) 869-5132. This is the closest campground, just 2 miles away, and likely the most reasonably priced, but not the best location. It is located right between a highway and a railway track so may be very noisy.

Wildrose Campground is better located than Whistlestop and only about 3 miles further from Downriver Farm. This, too, is fairly close to the train tracks but not between the tracks and the freeway. You can get information on their website, www.wildrosecamp.com. The address is 62030 Flood-Hope Rd., phone (604) 869-9842.

There are several motels in the Hope area that accept dogs.

Pack lunch/refreshments since there are no restaurants close by.

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward volunteer or competitor at a Herding Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue."

Sec 6.6.4 has been amended to read: ".....that dog may move up to compete at the next level the following calendar year...."
